## First Day of School--Thursday, August 20, 2020- 100% Distance Learning

- ASES not available until we begin hybrid model (hopefully at the beginning of October)
- Teachers and staff can meet with students one to one per Loleta Board decision Friday August 14.
- Tech delivered to homes by the end of Wednesday August 19.
- More chromebooks ordered to bring the school to 1:1.
- More hotspots have been ordered to allow all families to have one that need them.
- Teachers and staff reaching out to all families Tuesday and Wednesday to set up appointments.
- Meal Kits (including 5 days of breakfasts and lunches (10 meals) will be available for enrolled students only. Students/Parents and/or Guardians can pick up meal kits between 8am and 2pm. Students do not need to be present for meal pick up. There are two ways to pick up the meals: Walk-Up or Curbside.
  - Walk-Up: Walk up to the Cafeteria and let a staff member know how many meal kits are being picked up. The staff member will check off the students name on the Meal Counting Tally sheet and place the meal kit on a table for the person to then pick up. All local, state, and federal health, safety and sanitation rules and guidelines will be followed.
  - 2. Curbside: When the student/parent/guardian arrives, they will call the office and let them know they are picking up their students meal kit. They will wait in the vehicle. The office will call the Cafeteria. A staff member will bring the meal kits out to the vehicle and place the kit into the trunk of the vehicle for a no touch hand off. The staff member will then check off the students name on the Meal Counting Tally sheet. All local, state, and federal health, safety and sanitation rules and guidelines will be followed.

## Beginning the week of August 24th, meal kits will be distributed following this schedule:

Monday/Friday- no delivery

Tuesday- Table Bluff

Wednesday- Bear River Rancheria

Thursday- Loleta area beyond a mile from the school. Anyone living in the 1 mile area of Loleta will be responsible for picking up their 5 day meal kit at the school.

- When picking up their food boxes on Thursday, each student will receive a bankers box full of supplies and instructions from their teacher as to how to begin the online learning.
- Each teacher has a google classroom that will ask your student to log into. If you have any questions about how to do this please contact your teacher!
- Beginning the week of August 24th, Homework packets will be exchanged at each area on the same schedule as the food delivery.
- Tutors will also be available on the same schedule as food delivery from
  - o 1:30 3:30 pm.
  - Monday- no tutoring
  - Tuesday- Table Bluff
  - Wednesday- Bear River
  - Thursday Loleta school, Downtown, Cannibal Road and Copenhagen (note
     Cannibal Road and Copenhagen will be by appointment only.)
  - Friday- Appointments only.

All tutoring sessions will be first come, first serve unless you make an appointment by calling the school. Social distancing, masks and hand sanitizer will be used to maintain safety. The tutors will be sitting at desks outside as long as the weather is good.

 To help students with developing a good studying practice, Loleta is offering to allow families to borrow desks for their home. Please contact Lisa at the school to reserve a desk if this is something you feel you would like to have for your child.
